The **Huntingdonshire Mini Soccer League** for the forthcoming 2011-2012 season will be asking clubs to report the scores of games using the SMS message system provided by the Football Association as part of their "Full-Time" league administration package.

**How the Full-Time SMS Results system Works**

For each team, two mobile numbers can be registered. Initially we'll register the number of the "**Team Manager**", as he will be the person in the best position to report the score at the end of the match, but if you want the Club Secretary (or someone else) adding just let us know the names and mobile numbers. If there is a change in the person reporting the result please make sure you send us an update of their details at least 4 days before games kick off to give us time to process them. **(Results can only be made by "registered" telephones)**

During each game, the FA system will send an SMS Text Message to each registered mobile number, reminding you to send in the result of the game.

After the game, both home and away clubs should report the score by replying to their message using the word **RESULT** (followed by a space) and giving the score for the game, **home team first, away team second, and separated by a hyphen.**

For example:-

**FULL-TIME @TheFA CHE1 v MNU1 K.O. SUN 21 SEP 2008 14:00. Submit your result after the match as:-**

**RESULT H-A**

To report a 2-1 win to the home side (Chelsea 1sts!) you would simply reply:-

**RESULT 2-1**

The only exception is if you are registered to send in results for more than one team, in which case Full-Time will include a team code, which will be supplied to you from the Mini Soccer League. All you need to do is add this after the result so that Full-Time can identify which team is being reported. In the above example the text you would receive would say:-

**FULL-TIME @TheFA CHE1 v MNU1 K.O. SUN 21 SEP 2008 14:00. Submit your result after the match as:**

**RESULT H-A CHE1**

(note the CHE1 team code at the end) and the reply would be:-

**RESULT 2-1 CHE1**

It is important to note you should not add other information and that the text must begin with the word **RESULT** or Full-Time will ignore it. The text must be sent from one of the registered mobiles (as Full-Time identifies you by the mobile number it has been given).

Full-Time allows you to report postponements (**RESULT P-P**) and abandonment's (**RESULT A-A**).

**Hints and Tips**

If users are having problems with sending in results, please check the following:-

- Your message **must** start with **RESULT** – otherwise it won't reach Full-Time.
- If Full-Time asks for a team code, make sure it's included.
- Make sure you give the correct team code (if one is required) **after** the scores.
- Make sure you give the **home score first, away score second.**
- Tell the league if you change your mobile number!
- Tell the league if a fixture is incorrect on Full-Time before the game is played.

**F.A.FULL TIME AMENDMENT**

***SMS Result Changes (Aug 2011)***

The requirement to start a reply to the SMS Result system with **RESULT** has now been removed. From the start of August 2011, there is no longer the need for clubs to include the word **RESULT** at the start of their SMS replies to report scorelines. Full-Time will still process results if **RESULT** is included, but this should mean that there are fewer scorelines not being processed.
